

On Screen Logo Slide Templates

We're pleased that we are able to customize some screen time for your event! Not only will your logo appear on screen as the host, but you have the ability to create **up to three "slides"** that promote major sponsors of your event. This is valuable "screen-time" that should be reserved for your truly top sponsors—another selling point when seeking sponsorship. In many instances, only one additional slide will be needed.

If you need to create a screen image that has more than one logo on it, then you'll have to create the "slides" to exact specifications. But we've made it easy, don't worry!

Slide Size: 1920 (w) x1080 (h) pixels
Image Area: 1536 (w) x 864 (h) pixels (allows for 20% safety margins)
Resolution: 72 dpi
Color specs: RGB
Format: jpg or psd with layers

In the provided templates, the inner box is the safe zone—all content should be within this area in order to guarantee all content appears on screen.

Logo Info

We recommend working with logos that are vector files or high res enough that they look good on the big screen. Here are some tips to ensure this quality; both for your host logo and for your sponsor's logos.

- If you're only using your one host logo, just send the logo—no need to create a slide template. However, please send the logo you want us to use—not a file that contains multiple versions.
- Get an .eps file—this will be a vector file and easy to use. A vector means you can make the image as big as you want and you won't lose quality.
- Not sure the quality? An image that is a minimum of about 960 x 540 pixels wide should do it—if it's 1MB or larger it's probably ok, although smaller might be fine, too. Reach out to us if you're unsure and we'll help.
