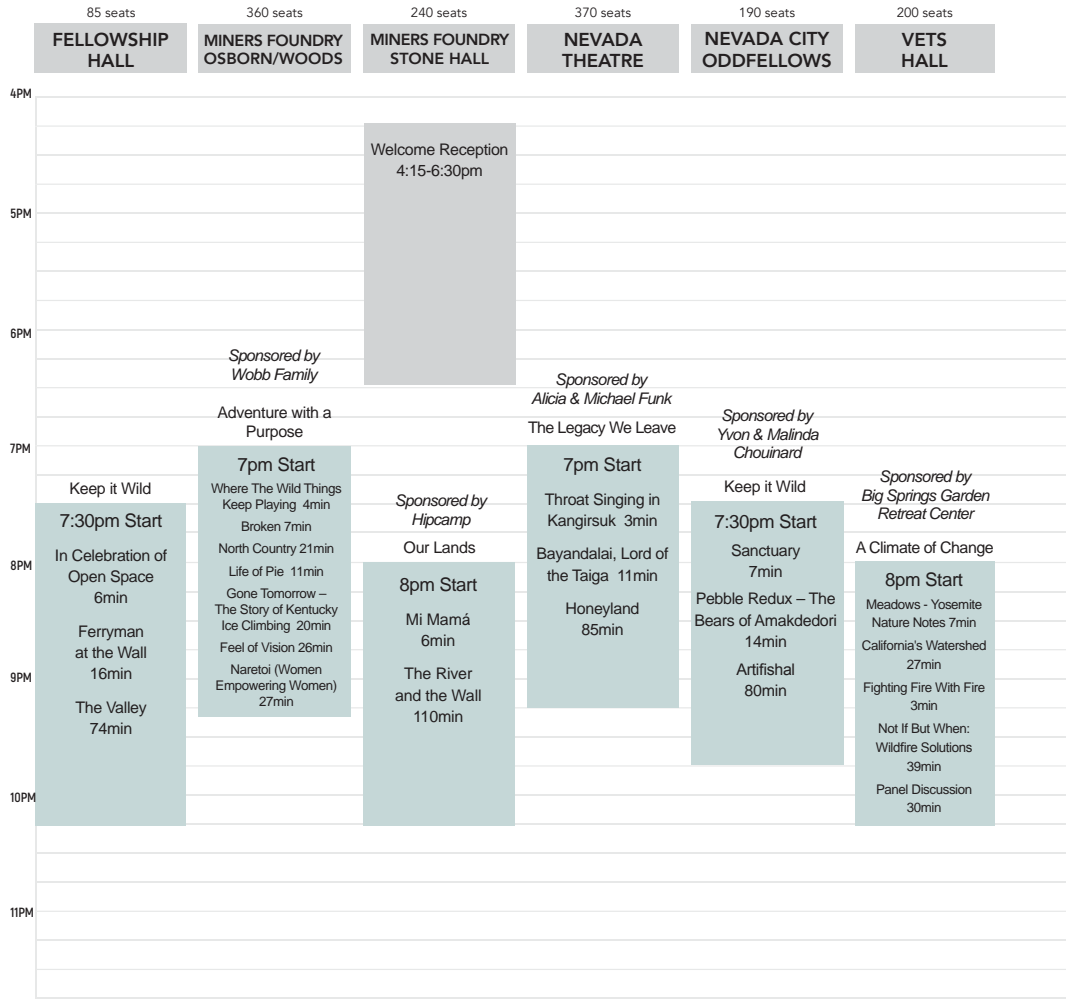

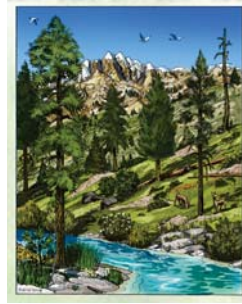

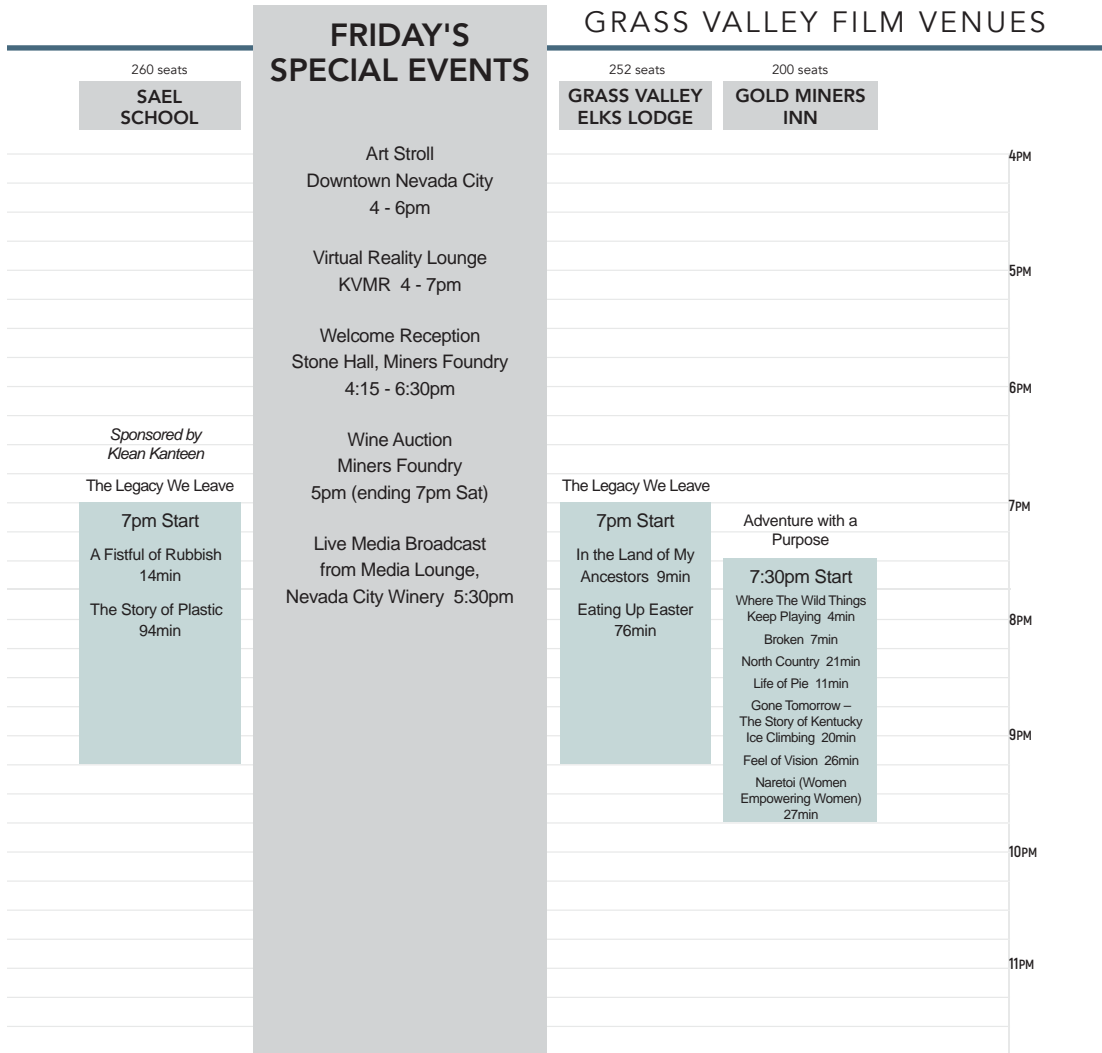
Healthy Forests for a Healthy Watershed

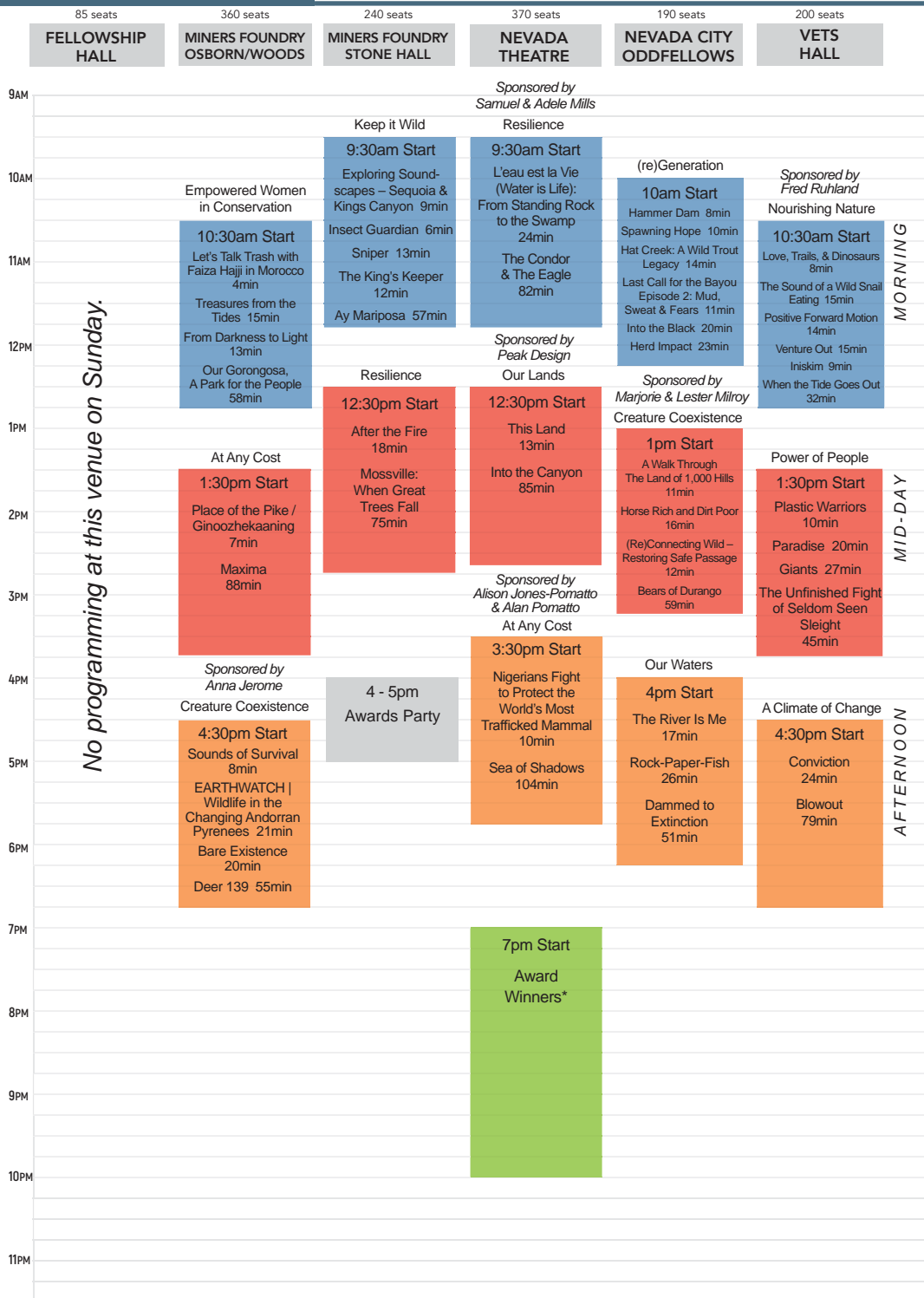

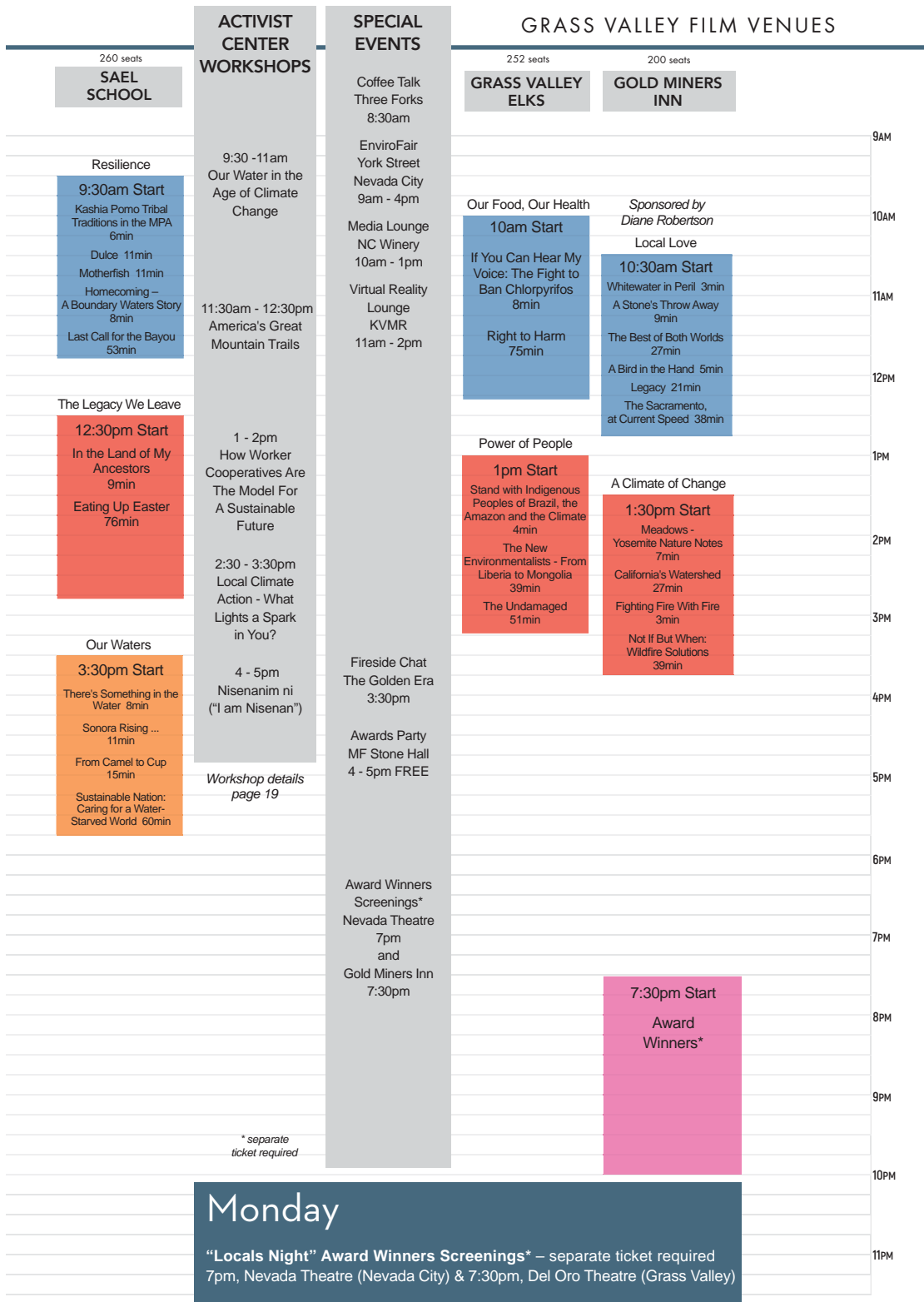
