Our WSFF Flagship Festival is one of the most celebrated film festivals in the United States, drawing more than 7,000 attendees to Northern California. It has 5 days of 100+ outdoor, nature, and adventure films, workshops, special panels, family-friendly programs, art exhibitions, parties, and more. It's the kick-off to our National On Tour program which brings Wild & Scenic film programs to communities across the country. 125+ WSFF events are hosted yearly by land trusts, waterkeepers, schools, and other community groups, reaching more than 40,000 people annually.
